Netball SA runs a number of umpiring courses during the year ranging from Introductory courses through to advanced courses. The Coloured Shirt Program run in association with The Office of Recreation and Sport and Netball SA is a program where new or inexperienced officials wear a coloured shirt that makes them easily recognisable to players and spectators. Mentoring and support is also provided to the beginner umpire to ensure the umpiring techniques they learn will provide a solid foundation for their continuing development.
